BikeAbility was great fun! The children learnt to be more aware of speed, how to spot hazards and show awareness of other people using the space. They learnt how to check their bikes to make sure that they were safe to use on the road including checking the tyres, brakes, chain and wheel alignment. They also learnt the importance of wearing the right clothing, including a properly fitted helmet. This gave the children a chance to practice in a safe environment with an experienced instructor on hand to help them learn the proper way to ride their bikes.

#### **Pupil Absence/Attendance Policy**

If your child is unwell and unable to attend school, you must let the school know as soon as possible (before 9 o'clock). Please phone the School Office on **01604 715658**. You should phone into school <u>every day</u> that your child is unwell. If we do not receive any information about your child's absence, school procedures including a same day home visit and further referrals to other agencies will be made as necessary. As you will also be aware, any absence of 5 consecutive school days will not be authorised and will be passed to the Educational Inclusion Partnership Team at the County Council and be subject to a fine.

#### **Mobile Phones**
